Dr. Robert McFarland and his wife, Jean, were the parents of Cynthia '75, Robert '76, David '79 and Mary Beth '81. Dr. McFarland served as team doctor for the Panthers football team for many years. He was extremely active with Elyria Catholic High School and cherished the opportunity his children had in receiving their educations at the school. Following his death the family established an endowed scholarship in his memory so that other young people might benefit from the same educational experience. The scholarship is intended for two (2) incoming freshmen who will be members of the graduating Class of 2023 and is renewable for all four years providing qualifying criteria are met.

- Shows financial need based on FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment ranking
- Applicant must submit an essay, "Why I Want to Attend Elyria Catholic High School."
